On **Sunday, January 4, 2015 at 4:30 p.m.**, two outstanding Detroit talents, French hornist **Rachel Childers** and violinist **Adrienne Rönmark**, are reunited as artists and friends with CSD artistic director and pianist Pauline Martin in a concert featuring the sublime Horn Trio in E flat by Johannes Brahms. The first female in history to be appointed to the Boston Symphony Orchestra brass section, Rachel assumed the post of Second Horn in 2011, while Adrienne Rönmark had followed in her parents' footsteps to become a member of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra in 2010.

Our subscription series concludes on **Monday April 13, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. Quintessence!** brings together Berlin Radio Orchestra colleagues, gifted Parisian violist **Jean-Baptiste Aguessy** and Detroit born cellist **Erik Åsgeirsson**, with CSD resident artists, University of Michigan faculty members **Aaron Berofsky** and **Kathryn Votapek** (violin), and pianist **Pauline Martin** in a magnificent program including starkly contrasted quintet masterpieces by Cesar Franck and Dmitri Shostakovich.
